

Community Futures

Small business owners and aspiring entrepreneurs can now access funding and advisory services all in one place as Community Futures has announced it will begin delivery of services provided by the Business Advisory Centre (BAC).





The BAC is a part of the Small Business
Enterprise Centre program, funded by the Province of Ontario through the
Ministry of Economic Development, Job Creation and Trade, previously
operated by Peterborough and the Kawartha's Economic Development
(PKED).

Entrepreneurs can leverage resources available at the Business Advisory Centre to help start or grow their businesses. Guidance on how to register your business, write a business plan or hire a first employee along with expert business advisors to provide counselling services and expansion support. In addition, advisory programs with a grant component including **Starter**Company Plus and Summer Company will be offered.

Community Futures Peterborough's BAC will open applications for Starter Company Plus this fall and assume delivery of advisory services immediately, working closely with the team at PKED.


