The program is designed to provide business training for entrepreneurs (from aspiring to experienced) in the





City of Peterborough and the County of Peterborough who are launching a business, expanding, or purchasing an existing business.

Starter Company Plus Includes:

• In-class training with experts in their fields to help you plan your business

• Training and assistance in writing a business plan that may help you obtain more traditional financing in the future if you require it

• One-on-one consultations with the program facilitator

• An opportunity to build your network with other local small business owners and start-ups

• Participants in the program will have access to a 6-month trial membership with the Peterborough and the Kawarthas Chamber of Commerce

• A conditional pre-approved microloan from Community Futures Peterborough

• Upon completing the program, participants will submit their final business plan and pitch for a chance to receive a grant of up to \$5,000.

The fall intake is now open and accepting applications until October 4th, 2024.



Governments Investing in Innovation to Strengthen Ontario's Agri-Food Sector

The governments of Canada and Ontario are investing an additional \$3.5 million into the Ontario Agri-Food Research Initiative (OAFRI). This funding, part of the Sustainable Canadian Agricultural Partnership (Sustainable CAP), will advance technologies for farmers, food processors, and agri-businesses, enhancing their competitiveness and growth.

With over 100 new projects funded, including innovations like digital biosecurity tools and improved data management for dairy farmers, OAFRI aims to drive forward Ontario's agri-food sector. The Grow Ontario Accelerator Hub (GOAH) will continue to offer expert advisory services to agri-food companies.
