Check your Chimney!

Before you light that wood stove or fireplace, the Selwyn Township Fire Dept. wants you to:

- Check your chimney for built up creosote before lighting. Creosote can cause a fire in the chimney if not properly cleaned out.
- Allow ashes to cool before emptying them into a metal container with a tight fitting lid. Keep the container outside and away from anything burnable!
- Check your CO detectors to make sure the batteries are working!
