

Strickland Street Watermain Replacement

The Township of Selwyn is undertaking a watermain replacement project along Strickland Street in Lakefield. The work has begun along Strickland Street from Queen Street to Prospect Street, and includes a portion of Prospect Street. Construction is set to be complete by Fall 2024.

Heading to the Beach?

Peterborough Public Health maintains a routine surveillance program for public beaches during summer months to ensure that the water quality is safe for swimming. Public beaches in Selwyn Township are sampled at least once every week. The water samples are tested for E. coli bacteria. It takes approximately 24 hours for the



health unit to receive and analyze the water quality results from the lab.

Water Restrictions in Effect!

Lakefield

*From May 15th to September 15th, watering may take place from 7:00 AM to 9:00 AM & from 6:00 PM to 10:00 PM.



*From June 1st to August 31st, watering may take place from 7:00 AM to 10:00 PM.



*Even numbered addresses on even days; Odd numbered addresses on odd days.



Clear bags must be used for curbside garbage collection and when taking garbage to the Smith Landfill. Black bags left for curbside collection will **not** be picked up. The purpose of clear bags is to ensure that garbage and recycling are separated.

Residents will be charged double for using solid coloured (ie. black) garbage bags at the Landfill.

Tax Relief for Low Income Seniors and Persons with Disabilities

If you receive the Guaranteed Income Supplement (GIS) or a payment under the Ontario Disability Support Program Act (ODSP), you may be eligible for tax relief equal to the amount your property taxes increased between 2023 and 2024, to a maximum of \$200.
