In order to sustain water quality in the water distribution system, the Peterborough Utilities Services once again intends to perform routine flushing of water mains throughout Lakefield.

## **Curbside Leaf and Yard Waste Collection**

Leaf and yard waste collection begins on Mondays at 7:00AM - but may occur any day throughout the week. Accepted items include:

- Leaves
- Branches\*, hedge and tree trimmings
- House and garden plants

Materials may be placed in paper bags or reusable containers for collection. Materials in plastic bags of any kind will **NOT** be collected.



\*Branches may be bundled with string no larger than 1m by 30cm (3' by 1'). No limit on the amount being picked up and no tags required.
