# Property Tax Reminder Letters

Property Tax Reminder Notices for outstanding balances will be sent only after an installment due date and at the end of the year. Penalty and/or interest is fixed at a rate of 1.25% per month and will continue to be added to unpaid taxes after the due date and the beginning of each month after. Reminder notices will be sent for accounts with an outstanding balance over \$10.00 at the beginning of **March**, **May, August, October, and December.**
